ACROSS THE AUCTION BLOCK

Massive Japanese artwork tops Epic Auctions at \$8,500

LESLIE, Mich. — There was a lot of excitement when a black and white abstract was opened for bids at Epic Auctions Summer Premier Auction.

The avant-garde calligraphy ink and wash on paper by Shiryu Morita (Japanese, 1912-1999) was housed in a metal frame measuring 42 by 55 inches. This massive work was originally pur-

chased directly from the artist in Kyoto, Japan, and was dated 1972. It bore the artist's chop mark and label. Coming from the private collection of the original owner, it soared to a final bid of \$8,500.

Left: Gauer and Coble Studios lamp in the "Apple Blossom and Web" pattern stood 28 inches tall. It sold for \$3,750.



Brad Stoeker of Epic Auctions described the auction as "one of those auctions that reminds collectors why they started collecting in the first place — a convergence of quality and variety that is genuinely difficult to find in a single sale." There was indeed a vast selection of collectibles, art, and antiques to appeal to a wide spectrum of interests. Brad was assisted at the podi-

The sweet smell of collecting Art Deco perfume bottles

Like most antique hobbies, collecting perfume bottles has a name.

People who collect these bottles are known as "perfume connoisseurs," which is a name that has evolved over time, but the meaning is known to all

collectors — a deep appreciation for a perfume bottle's artsy look and the undeniable art of the bottle's scent.

The earliest perfume

bottles known to historians date to Egypt, circa 1,000 BC. Egyptians are credited with inventing glass, and perfume bottles were one of the first common uses for glass.

Today, though, most collectors look for Art Deco glass perfume bottles, created from 1920-1940; although, the selling of expensive perfume bottles tapered off dramatically during the Great Depression of the 1930s.

Geometric shapes, luxurious materials like crystal glass, and streamlined designing, characterize most Art Deco perfume bottles. Original Art Deco perfume bottles were created with hand-blown crystal glass that was then hand-cut in daz-

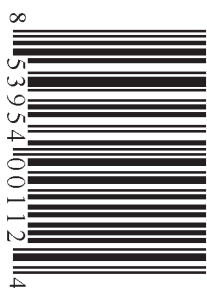

zling arrays of geometric shapes and designs. As the 1920s passed into the 1930s, perfume bottles that were once handmade became mass produced,

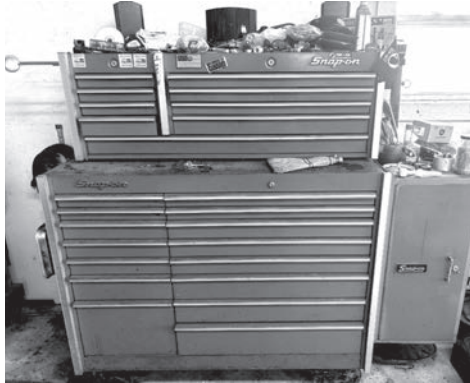

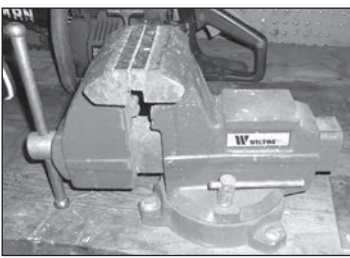

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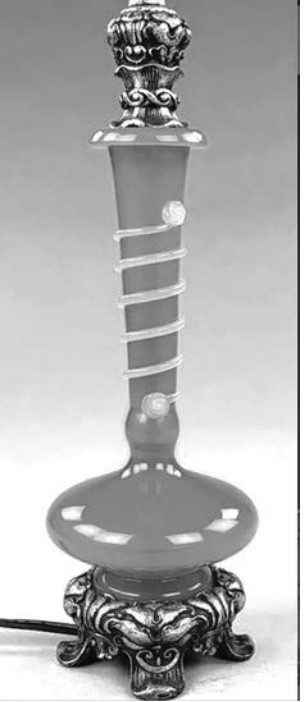

sured 28 inches tall by 20 inches wide and had been created by this small production studio that made both the bases as well as the shades. This highly sought after prize was claimed with a high bid of \$3,750.

A handsome Danish Modern wall unit designed by Poul Cadovius (Danish, 1911-2011) for Cado provides a floating, modular storage system that looks great and helps conserve floor space. The eight teak wood cabinets of various sizes with sliding doors and internal shelves were offered along with their mounting strips and corner brackets. They left for a new home with a high bid of \$950.

A graceful Steuben Glass Art Deco art glass center bowl, in the “De But” pattern drew an enthusiastic response. Finished in a blue aurene over green jade it was designed by Frederick Carder (English/American, 1863-1963) and dated to approxi-

mately 1929. This attractive 12-inch diameter bowl was claimed with a final bid of \$800. A pair of Steuben Glass candlesticks also performed well. With twisted stems and flared tops done in the blue aurene finish, they were a nice match for the bowl. Standing 12 inches tall, the pair was taken with a final bid of \$800. A Steuben Glass rose colored American art glass “Cluthra” vase, 10 inches tall, finished at \$500. Stoecker described another Stueben piece as the sleeper of the auction. It was a glass bottle form vase mounted as a boudoir or table lamp, from the Frederick Carder (English/American, 1863-1963) era. The delicate green jade colored glass with applied alabaster colored glass threading and silvered metal mountings was supported by a robust bronze base. It measured 24 inches

tall, dated to circa 1920-1930, and required a final bid of \$475 to take it home.

A massive antique Kramer Brothers (Dayton, Ohio) Rococo Revival painted cast iron garden bench or settee was intricately designed and very attractive despite the paint loss. It was in very good structural condition and likely dated to the late 19th/early 20th century. It measured 43 inches long by 35 inches tall and left with a final bid of \$450.

A very handsome A.H. Andrews and Company (Chicago & New York), antique black walnut S-curve roll-top desk, circa 1880s/1890s presented an impressive addition to any office. It featured eight drawers, numerous compartments, pull-out writing slides, and original brass handles. It was tastefully embellished with hand-

carved floral, leaf and berry decoration on the sides, back, and internal panels. Despite some damage it still finished strong with a final bid of \$325.

An Odin Rosenvinge (English, 1880-1957), framed Dutch advertising travel poster depicted the Canadian Pacific ocean liner with two yellow smokestacks departing Liverpool harbor with a cityscape in the background. Across the top it read “ANTWERPEN - KANADA EN VEREENIGDE STATEN” in bold black letters. It measured 41 by 28 inches, and had sustained some damage, but the colorful poster still earned a final bid of \$350.

A Franklin Mint limited-edition rose sculpture commissioned to celebrate the 25th wedding anniversary of Prince Rainier III and Princess Grace of Monaco, featured a gold-toned metal rose with green enameled leaves and pearl-like accents. Mounted on a green marble base and labeled with the commemorative message it was dated 1981 and bore serial number 169/750. This elegant piece was claimed with a final bid of \$325 despite missing the original removable 18K diamond and emerald brooch.

There were numerous examples of wall art. A particularly beautiful and stunning piece proved popular and performed well. Nick Kosciuk (American, b. 1964), cre-

ated a painting titled “Warmth of the Red Chair”. It was signed by the artist and depicted a young woman huddled into the comfort of a stuffed red chair. It measured 42 by 31 inches, was presented in a gilt wood and gesso frame

and had no reported damage. It was rehomed with a final bid of \$275.

and Art Deco and other types of perfume bottles suffered in appearance, design, uniqueness, and finally value.

Art Deco, during its heyday in the 1920s, represented luxury, glamour, and exuberance, which might have been what attracted so many women to Art Deco perfume bottles. Art Deco glassware, such as perfume bottles, was styled and cut in technologically advanced ways, which also attracted the modern eye. Chrome plating was used on Art Deco perfume bottles, which was considered quite advanced technology at the time.

The Great Depression greatly hurt the Art Deco movement, especially in glass art like expensive perfume bottles. Art Deco, during the '30s, took on a sleeker style called Streamline Moderne, which, following World War II, evolved into modern art styles.

One of the most famous producers of Art Deco perfume bottles was René Lalique, whose glass works, from vases to hood ornaments for automobiles, became symbols of the Art Deco movement. He experimented designing perfume bottles for François Coty.

Today, collectors eagerly seek Lalique glass perfume bottles, paying a nice dividend for them.

Other Art Deco glass artists helped produce a wide variety of practical glass objects in the easily identified Art Deco styling. Of all the Art Deco glass products, perfume bottles have proven the easiest to collect, the easiest to transport, and the best guarantee of stable, rising prices.

Emma Longstaff "Collecting perfume bottles" that appeared in Homes & Antiques explained, "Perfume bottles have a very practical function — they contain the concoctions used to anoint our hair, bodies and clothes. In the centuries before modern sanitation, for those who could afford them, perfumes disguised the obnoxious stench of unwashed bodies, smoking factories and streets clogged with rainwater and waste. But despite the usefulness of perfume, scent bottles have rarely been straightforwardly utilitarian objects."

Ken Leach, a famous perfume connoisseur perfectly summed up why people love to collect Art Deco perfume bottles, perfume bottle "makers have always tried to 'seduce the eye and the hand' before the bottle

was opened or the stopper was even lifted. Because of this, perfume bottles are often exquisite examples of particular moments in design history," such as the Art Deco movement.

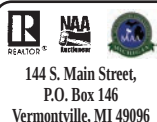

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EDS offered impressive selection of Nathan Margolis furniture

BLOOMINGTON, Ind. — Nathan Margolis learned the furniture maker's trade from his grandfather in late 19th century Russia, honing his craft in London at the British Gillow furniture house in the early 1890s.

Immigrating to the United States, he opened his own shop in Hartford, Conn., in 1894. He became a sought-after craftsman of Colonial Revival furniture. While Nathan died in 1925, family members kept the firm going until 1976.

Pieces of his work in the Colonial Revival, Federal, and Queen Anne styles went on auction block of Estate and Downsizing Specialists (EDS) in early July. Realized prices do not include a buyer's premium.

The top selling Margolis example was an imposing Federal style secretary desk that was hammered after 51 bids at \$875. The figured mahogany panels, shaped door moldings, bracket feet, brass hardware, and gallery-style cornice give it far more presence than most ordinary

reproduction secretaries.

A 1912 Margolis sideboard reached \$700. With a handsome display face, strong Federal-style form, serpentine/bowed front, figured mahogany veneers, and oval brasses the piece looked dashing on its finely lathed tapered legs. It carried a handwritten paper note stating that it was made for a J. C. Hart by Nathan Margolis.

"This is the best looking sideboard you will ever see," auctioneer Bri-

an Sample said. "Margolis made some of the most outstanding 20th century American furniture there is."

A three-bay mahogany bookcase with glazed glass doors reached \$625. The carved frieze, warm mahogany color, lower drawers, and ball-and-claw feet made it the most usable Margolis-related piece in the sale, furniture a buyer could immediately fill with books, porcelain, or family silver.

Campbell also observed that Margolis and his family executed prestigious commissions for John D. Rockefeller III, the du Ponts, the Connecticut governor's residence, and Yale University. The Dallas Museum of Art has a Margolis piece in its 21st century decorative-arts collection.

The top selling decorative lot was a Reed and Barton sterling tea set that reached \$3,500. Monogrammed "H" for the Hartford, Conn., Hart family, the five-piece sterling tea and coffee service weighed a listed 2,988 grams. The set, which included a coffee pot, teapot, covered tea caddy, and open sugar and cream pitchers, brought a strong price though still below its theoretical silver value.

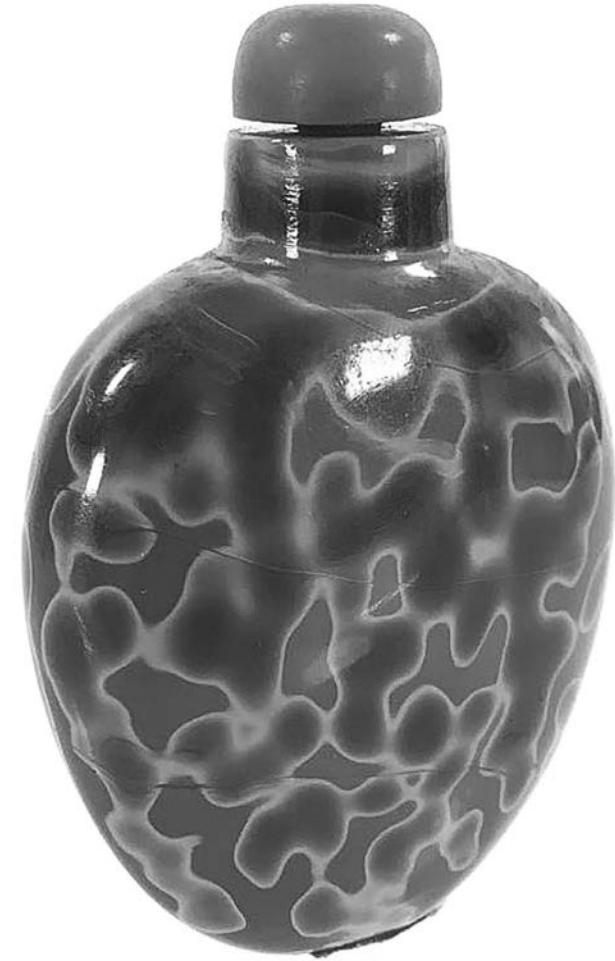

ivory spoon was priced at \$475. Modeled after an orange arsenic mineral called realgar, Qing glass-makers simulated the mineral's fiery look without the arsenic. A pair of Chinese painted porcelain snuffs, one an example of Chinese blue-and-white Transferware and another with stylized Chinese characters, was hammered at \$275.

More than 40 bids were placed on a Loetz Art Nouveau Bohemian glass vase cataloged as signed that sold for \$2,500. The 9-inch vase featured an iridescent gold surface, pulled feather-like decoration, a flared blossom-form rim, and six ribbed feet, giving it the organic movement associated with early 20th-century Central European art glass.

A pair of larger American School oil paintings presumed to depict Joseph Clark Hart (1850-1942) and Alice Eliza Hart (1858-1925) achieved \$1,500. Cataloged as academic quality portraits with simplified
