ACROSS THE AUCTION BLOCK

1987 Oldsmobile drove away with a \$27,500 bid

COTTREVILLE, Mich. — Located on the east edge of the state just north of Lake St. Clair, Cottrellville was the site of a recent estate dispersal conducted by Chuck Cryderman & Associates Auctions. Divided into

two sales, the house was sold as one auction lot and the contents, including classic cars, guns, and tools, made up the second one. The previous owner maintained his equipment in top notch condition. Prices here do not include the buyer's premium.

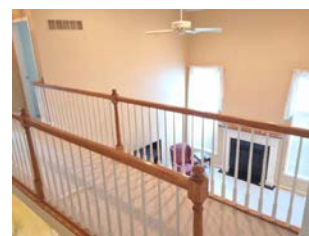
The real estate auction offered an incredible 2,753 square foot, two-story home on 4.7 acres. In addition to a 2-car garage there was also a heated pole barn workshop and a full basement. Two bedrooms on the ground floor and two more upstairs were accompanied by 2.5

spacious baths and numerous closets. Located on a paved road and fronted by a paved driveway, this immaculate home with so many extras such as a fireplace, wood floors, high ceilings, and a graceful second floor loft railing that overlooked the great room below presented a very appealing package. The new owner was able to secure it with a final bid of \$422,500.

Many of the leading lots in the estate auction consisted of a variety of cars, starting with the 1987 Oldsmobile 442 with one original owner. It showed an odometer reading of 14,918 miles, included a T-top, and was reported to run and drive great. The glossy black finish set off a car that was exceptionally well maintained. The only fault reported was a

minor rear bumper dent. This handsome vehicle was rehomed with a final bid of \$27,500.

The 2019 Chevy Silverado LD 1500 4-door, full-sized pickup truck in showroom condition was

likely the workhorse of this stable. It featured a 5.3L EcoTec3 V8 engine, 6 speed automatic transmission, and roll bars mounted to the truck bed.

Collectors of chess sets keep playing the game

When I visited the British Museum in London, a few years ago, I was fascinated by the museum's display of the

Lewis chessmen. I'm a recreational chess player, so the Lewis Island chess pieces enthralled me enough to buy a replicated Lewis Island chess set in the museum's gift shop. I still have this set

displayed in my living room.

The Lewis Island chessmen, named after the island where they were found, are sometimes called the Uig chessmen since they were found in Uig Bay. These chess pieces were mostly hand-carved from walrus ivory in the 12th century in Norway, and they were discovered in 1831 on the Isle of Lewis in Scotland. Of the 84 pieces found, 82 are exhibited in the British Museum, 11 are displayed at the National Museum of Scotland in Edinburgh, and one Lewis chess piece is owned in a private collection.

The game of chess originated over 1,500 years ago in India and was

called chaturanga, which was a game simulating opposing, military units. Chaturanga traveled the

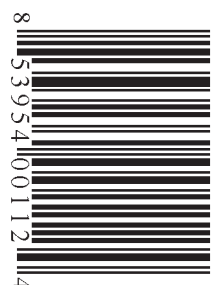
legendary Silk Road to Persia where the game evolved into the game of shatranj. Shatranj

The 4-wheel drive provided desirable options, and with 83,175 miles on it the truck was reported to run and drive well. Even the air conditioning worked for the future owner who claimed it with a final bid of \$19,250.

The eye-catching red 2017 Cadillac ATS 2.0 turbo all-wheel-drive compact luxury sports sedan had also seen a lot of road time, with a mileage reading of 83,737 miles, but that did not diminish its condition. This very clean, well-running vehicle also had functional air conditioning and no reported flaws or defects. Ready for its next adventure, it left with a final bid of \$8,470. Other cars in the sale included a 1975 metallic light saddle brown Chevrolet Camaro type original to this owner with a 350 engine that closed at

\$7,150 and a massive burgundy-plum 1966 Oldsmobile Toronado 455 rocket, not currently in running condition, that still garnered a \$4,400 high bid. A very useful 2018 Cynergy 30-foot-long cargo or car hauler trailer was available. This spacious bumper-pull model had a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of 9,900 pounds. It had a fold down ramp

in the rear for loading and a side door for easy entry access. It finished with a final bid of \$8,140. A dual axle Tandem car hauler trailer with ramps and a winch was taken with a final bid of \$1,320 and an 8-foot-long single axle landscape trailer with railings and a fold down ramp went for a \$506 bid.

Zero turn lawn mowers are a very popular option and there were two to choose from here. The Ariens zero turn mower with 52-inch deck was equipped with a Kawasaki FR691V- 23 HP engine and was relatively new with only 45 hours on it. It was the one in use for lawn mowing right up until the sale and was in top running order. It left with a final bid of \$2,200. Another Ariens, this time a model IKON XD 60 zero turn mower with 145 hours, 60 inch cutting deck, and the same engine was reported to run well but the parking brake would not release. The new owner was ready to handle this, taking the mower with a final bid of \$1,760.

There were a few firearms sold at this estate sale. The leader of the pack was the Remington 308 Winchester model 700 bolt-action rifle with heavy barrel. Advertised as versatile, accurate, and reliable, this one was equipped with a Leopold scope and a short bipod for ease of use. Complete with a custom-made hard shell gun case, it was taken with a final bid of \$1,100. A Winchester model 94-30 W.C.F. lever action rifle also in good, clean condition earned a high bid of \$880. A Smith and Wesson 9MM model 6906 handgun with four magazines and original case drew a final bid of \$506.

The bulk of the auction consisted of clean tools and home technology that had all been enjoyed by the former owner. Some of the tools included a stellar U.S. General two-piece rolling toolbox that had only received light use. The 16 drawers plus the

hinged top compartment were loaded with tools, making it ready for the next workshop. It was claimed with a final bid of \$242. A smaller, five-drawer unit finished with a \$187 bid. A reliable Generac 5000 watt generator mounted on a trailer with a handle, trailer hitch, and pneumatic tires was another desirable addition. This multi-featured power source earned a high bid of \$176.

The emerging field of 3D printing was represented by the Bambu Lab X-1 carbon 3D printer. Offered with eight color filaments and their holders, this high speed, multi-color device was claimed with a final bid of \$1,045. A Samsung Ultra High Definition (UHD) 75-inch flatscreen television still in the original box provided an

opportunity to purchase a bargain. This model CU7000D equipped with a 4K crystal processor was relocated with a final bid of \$440. For recreational tech, there was a black 03 Maxis-Team radio controlled (RC) 4-wheel drive high speed off road buggy

with remote control and rechargeable battery. This realistic model was captured with a final bid of \$253.

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Potterypalooza will feature work of Overbeck sisters

RICHMOND, Ind. – Overbeck pottery will be one of the highlights of this year's Potterypalooza held at the Richmond Art Museum on Sept. 12. There will be a festival with opportunities to meet contemporary ceramicists, as well as purchase their wares. Inside the museum an outstanding exhibition of Overbeck will be on display.

Introduced 12 years ago, Potterypalooza, is a one-day festival, held from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and hosted by the Museum. More than 30 top clay artisans from Ohio and Indiana will be highlighted in the juried art show, exhibiting their wares on the front lawn of the Museum.

Rounding out the festival's offerings that day will be live music and a Kids Clay Zone, a pottery wheel demonstration and, of course, a variety of food choices.

Between 800 and 1,000 people are expected to attend according to Shaun Dingwerth, executive director of the museum.

Those in attendance for outdoor activities will, at the same time, have the opportunity to tour the Richmond Art Museum, where, from now until January, Bob Ammerman will exhibit a sizable portion of his extensive collection of Overbeck Pottery. Thanks to personal ties to the Overbecks, Ammerman has been a longtime enthusiast of the family-operated, home-based enterprise, established in nearby Cambridge City, Ind. For nearly half a century, from 1911 to 1955, the Overbeck sisters combined their talents to produce a variety of wares. Their contributions to the Arts and Crafts Movement are increasingly appreciated today, Ammerman noted.

Although pieces from Ammerman's collection

have been exhibited locally in the past, this is the first time he will be exhibiting part of his sizable collection at the Richmond Art Museum. On display will be an array of wares, including tableware, vases, and figurines as well as related ephemera. Explaining in part his love of all things Overbeck, Ammerman commented, "Not everyone can collect something made in their hometown." By exhibiting at the Museum, Ammerman hopes to educate pottery collectors. Once solely distributed locally, Overbeck Pottery has caught the eye of collectors around the country. With this burgeoning interest, he said, comes an increased number of reproductions on the market.

The Overbeck sisters were active in what was originally called the Richmond Art Association, founded in 1898. There, the sisters taught painting and pottery classes, as well as serving on the board of directors. The Art Association, now the Richmond Art Museum, is believed to be the only art museum in the nation to be permanently housed in a public high school building. In exchange for no utility fees and a rent-free space, the Museum offers free admission and free children's programs.

Today, what is the second oldest art museum in the State of Indiana

is the repository for approximately 300 Overbeck-related objects, with examples of pottery as well as sketches and photographs. To complement Ammerman's exhibition, the Museum's rotating permanent exhibit will include additional Overbeck Pottery items, ones that are not normally on display. And at the end of the day, for longtime collectors, as well as the curious, this convergence of both old and new ceramics in Richmond will be, in the words of Dingwerth, "a tremendous opportunity."

The Richmond Art Museum is located on Route 40, east of Indianapolis on the Ohio border. Ammerman's exhibition will be on display throughout the year, according to Dingwerth; regular museum hours are Tuesday through Saturday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Admission to the Richmond Art Museum is free, as is admission to Potterypalooza.

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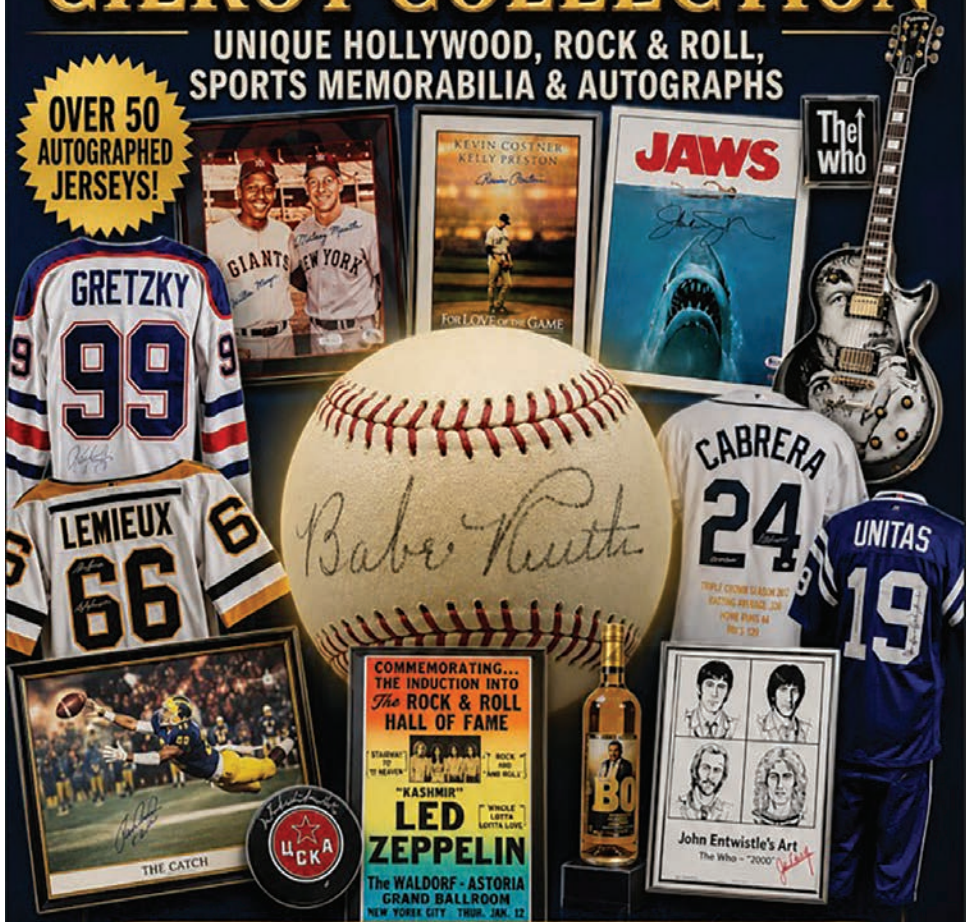

the game evolved into the modern game of chess sometime in the late-15th century.

The oldest chess pieces known are the Afrasiab Chessmen, excavated in 1977 in modern-day Uzbekistan. These seven pieces were created in the 8th century from carved ivory.

Another early chess

set, the Nishapur Set was made in the 12th century from ceramic fritware.

Many people offer advice on collecting chess sets. Sukanya Mukherjee, writing for The House of Staunton website, had this to say, “Chess isn’t just a game. It’s an art form, a slice of history, and for some, an obsession. Collecting chess sets isn’t as simple as finding something old or aesthetically pleas-

ing.”

The Chess Museum, at www.chess-museum.com, takes a different view on collecting chess sets, “Collecting chess [sets] is a natural outcome of a major and pervading interest in the game of chess. We start collecting mainly out of nostalgia...or of a fascination with the basics of whatever field of human activity captures our fancy.”

If you seriously see

chess sets as art forms, and you have deep, deep pockets, the five most expensive chess sets in the world, according to www.houseofstaunton.com, are

The Emperors’ Chess Table, \$2,608,075; Battle of Issus Chess Set, \$1,650,000; The Christian I Von Munch Chess Set, \$547,192; Pagoda Figurines Chess Set, valued between \$262,600 - \$393,900, and the Marcel Du Champ Pocket Chess Set, valued between \$200,000 - \$300,000.

At over \$2.5 million, The Emperors’ Chess Table may be unrealistic for most collections. Albert Williams designed it in 1866, and Tsar Alexander II once owned it. The set’s value of \$2,608,075 was set at Christie’s Auction in 2014. Among the emperors depicted on these chess pieces are Charlemagne, Alexander the Great, Napoleon, and Timur. It has been said that the “set’s entire appearance invokes memories of Renaissance paintings,” proving, perhaps, some chess sets are truly works of art.

as American Chess Day in the United States. The day is dedicated to the promoting and collecting of classic chess games, strategy, and playing. There is also a National Chess Day, which President Gerald Ford made official and is celebrated on the second Saturday of October. Finally, there is also an International Chess Day which is celebrated world-wide on July 20,

but, if truth be told, any day is a great day to sit in front of a roaring fire place, sip a hot herbal tea, and engage in a warring game of chess.

Chess Collectors International is a worldwide association of chess set, both of artistic and historical importance, collectors. More information may be obtained at www.chesscollectorsinternational.org.

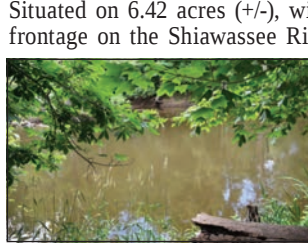
