ACROSS THE AUCTION BLOCK

Advertising cabinet opened an \$800 bid at Whalen

GRAND RAPIDS, Ohio — With the crowd eager to pick up a piece of history that brought back childhood memories or stories from grandparents or parents, the recent Whalen

Auction Company toy and advertising auction drew a good crowd.

An advertising cabinet could still be used today for storage and was a real showpiece. This two-piece unit had hand-painted advertising that was still in amazing shape considering the age. "Sutton's Family General Store" was painted across the top. There was storage for butter and general cheeses, hung game, teas, eggs, ham, and other items. It was like a small one-stop grocery store. The dark-colored finish of the wood made the lettering stand out.

To own this piece of history, the selling price was hammered down to \$800.

A second display piece from an old general store was a Remington glass fountain pen display. It was filled with Sheaffer pens and was in great shape. It was a small tabletop display that would have stood on the counter by the cash register. It sold for \$500.

An old cider dispenser sold for \$525. This one

was clearly marked "Alaska Frappe Old Fort Cider Works." This drink dispenser was still showing off the original globe and tray. One foot had the marble replaced.

Flowers and skulls fascinated artist Georgia O'Keeffe

Georgia Totto O'Keeffe (1887-1986) was an American modernist painter. Her art career spanned over seven

decades, and historically she is known as the Mother of American Modernism.

O'Keeffe was born in Wisconsin and died in New Mexico at the age of 98. By the time of her

death, she was nearly blind due to macular degeneration, but she continued painting from memory, even though she could not see the canvas. In her lifetime, she produced more than 2,000 paintings. As early as 1928, her lily paintings sold for as much as \$25,000, which, at that time, was the most money paid for a living American artist's work.

She began art studies at the Art Institute of Chicago in 1905, continuing her studies for nearly 15 years at different institutions. To help pay for her studies, O'Keeffe



served as a commercial illustrator. As a student at the University of Virginia, Arthur Wesley Dow greatly influenced her work. It was while

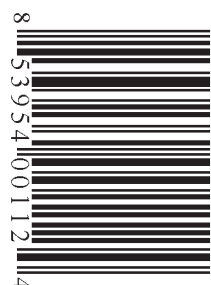

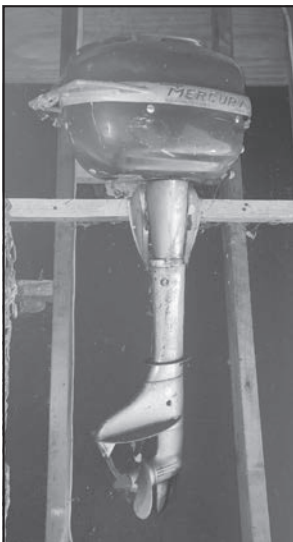

The piece came out of Toledo, Ohio. It was a great piece with the old tin bottom and the glass globe marking a distant separation of what the customer saw and where

the air for ages was a real crowd pleaser. This Willys Overland dealership pennant was all original, and so were the business cards that accompanied it. Even though it had some stains, that just added patina, which made the sellers want to tuck it away and take it home. The final bid price on this unusual piece of history from a dealership was \$450.

A couple of beauty shop signs competed for bidders. One measuring 24 by 12 inches sold for \$325. This one said "Beauty Shop" and had a lady on the side with a nice wavy hairstyle. The other one was smaller, measuring 12 by 22 inches and sold for \$245. It lacked the lady and the business name. Both of these signs were

flange signs.

With a shiny silver base and top, a Peerless Bluebird one-cent gumball machine brought an impressive bid of \$325. Someone had shined it up so it displayed beautifully and brought hopes of putting in a penny and getting a gumball as a reward. A second one-cent gumball machine had been restored and was an enticing display. With a

red top and bottom, it was more like one would remember from childhood. This restored piece sold for \$300.

A Smith Miller delivery truck had a blue cab and a trailer with a large section cut out in the center, with a chain across the opening. It sold for \$235.

A Wyandotte Coast to Coast pressed-steel bus sold for \$250. It had a white front, and

the passenger part was sky blue. A sticker on the side declared it was a Coast to Coast service.

And if a child wanted to float away to a land too far to take the bus, a pedal boat could have been the answer. This one was in good shape and brought a final bid of \$425.

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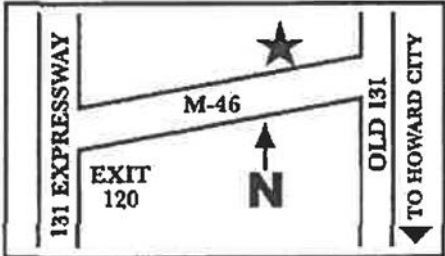

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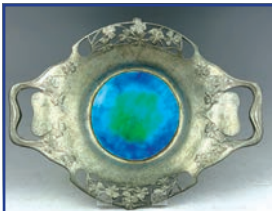

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Hallmark paper dolls send a wholesome message

“You’ll find collecting Hallmark Dolls is really lots of fun, and here’s a little album with a place for every one!” — Hallmark, 1948

Over the years, almost every person of note (or notoriety) has been immortalized as a colorful paper doll. Paper dolls have honored everyone from movie and TV stars to politicians to Pope John Paul II.

Most show their age, thanks to the young fingers which have tried impatiently to dress them. There are frayed edges. Creased midsections. Missing or bent clothing tabs. From stubborn Scotch tape to indelible crayon markings, the pitiful paper stories are never-ending.

Exceptions to the well-

Quite simply put, Smith’s illustrations succeeded because they are so much more colorful, intricate, and fully realized than a paper doll really needs to be.

For “Viv,” (her identifying signature), accuracy, laced with a dash of whimsy, was all-important. Check out “Katrinka of Holland”: the ethnic garb has been lovingly recreated — but from the yoke she’s carrying dangle two gigantic wooden shoes, packed to overflowing with tulips. Then there’s “John, A Royal Canadian Mountie,” who carries a rifle and a pair of snowshoes nearly as tall as he is, and “Tautuk of Alaska,” with a winsome seal and a grinning fish as his cheery com-

loved-well-worn rule are dolls released by Hallmark in the late 1940s:

Below: “Katrinka of Holland.”

“Dolls From The Land of Make Believe,” “Dolls of the Nations,” and the “Little Women Dolls.” Many can still be found in the colorful and pristine condition that delighted young collectors when the dolls made their debut.

The reason is simple: each set came with its own “Collector’s Album.” Doting parents were encouraged to “buy the album with the first doll; then, add to your little girl’s collection from time to time. She can take them out to play with—put them back to keep them looking fresh as new.”

Also, unlike other paper dolls, each Hallmark doll arrived fully dressed, on sturdy card stock, “resplendent with real plumes and sparkling sequins.” While this may have limited the playtime possibilities (take them out, stand them up, look at them, put them away), it did cut down significantly on wear and tear, for which present-day collectors are grateful.

The three Hallmark sets were the work of artist Vivian Trillow Smith, and her attention to imaginative detail is the primary reason they remain so collectible.

studying there that her unique artistic style began developing through her watercolors. Her work as a modernist artist developed through her abstract charcoal drawings that she produced around 1915.

In 1916, through art dealer and friend Alfred Stieglitz, O'Keeffe held the first exhibit of her works. She quickly gained worldwide recognition for her paintings of natural forms, such as flowers, skulls, and desert-inspired landscapes. As she developed as an artist, she became infatuated with drawing and painting the world as she saw it — the places and environments in which she lived and worked.

In all, O'Keeffe painted about 200 paintings of flowers, which was 1/10th of her career output. Ironically, she once said, "I hate flowers — I only paint them because they're

cheaper than models and they don't move." Later, in another interview, she added, "When you take a flower in your hand and really look at it, it's your world for the moment. I want to give that world to someone else. Most people in the city rush around so, they have no time to look at a flower. I want them to see it whether they want to or not." Whether she liked flowers or not, she was inspired by them.

She loved to reduce nature to its simplest perspective, such as her oil on canvas *The Green Apple*, which she painted in 1922. Now hanging in the Birmingham Museum of Art, most art critics call *The Green Apple* "inspired Precisionism" since a simple green apple resting on a black circular tray perfectly conveys her ideas of a simple, meaningful life. On this work and others, O'Keeffe said, "It is only by selection, by elimination, and by emphasis that we get at the real meaning of things." From this work we realize that all life is

similar to this green apple, and to perfect any life, one must be as complete in his/her life as the apple is in its life.

In 1922 journalist Paul Rosenfeld stated the essence of O'Keeffe's "very womanhood permeates her pictures, citing her use of color and shapes as metaphors for the female body." Rosenfeld went on to describe her paintings in sexually suggestive manners.

From 1922 until today, much of her work, especially her detailed flower paintings are interpreted to be abstracts on female sexuality. O'Keeffe venomously rejected this notion. She was adamant throughout her career that none of her floral works of art had anything to do with male or female genitalia.

Some of O'Keeffe's most disturbing art is found in her skull and desert paintings.

She painted the desert landscape in which she lived for over 50 years, roughly 1930s through her death in 1986. The multi-

colored cliffs and changing landscape of Mexico inspired many of her most famous works. In 1936 she completed what would become, possibly, the fruition of her work — *Summer Days*. This brightly colored, oil on canvas depicts a buck deer skull with humongous antlers suspended over a mountainous desert landscape with wildflowers hovering between the skull and earth.

Critics interpreted *Summer Days* as mystical; however, true to herself, O'Keeffe refused to assign any symbolic meaning to her work. She considered the use of flowers, skulls, and desert landscapes as the raw, alive essence of



the desert and world in which she painted, and she merely painted what she saw, calling *Summer Days*, "a portrayal of summertime."

If you want to know more about Georgia

O'Keeffe and her contribution to American art, Goodreads list a total of 119 books about her life. The most popular book and most read is "Georgia O'Keeffe" by Georgia O'Keeffe.

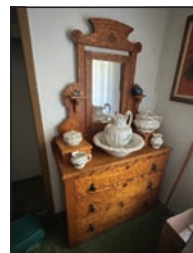

panions. The inherent playfulness of Smith’s designs must have delighted children of the 1940s and ‘50s as much as they delight the collectors of today.

Hallmark dolls were intended to be free-standing. Since that meant illustrations were needed on both front and back, Smith made sure her characters were eye-catching from any angle. The reverse of “Rita from Brazil,” for example, boasts elabo-

rate jewelry and floral head décor entirely different from that on the front, while “Bobby Shaf-toe’s” flowing cape is emblazoned with a series of regal “S’s.” Such attentive care is indicative of a truly accomplished artist, for whom “good enough” only served as a starting point.

“Dolls From The Land of Make Believe” came first, in 1947, their album featuring a cover photo of Disney child star Luana Patten. The lineup of 16 figures standing 5 ½ by 7 inches, “looking as though they stepped right out of

fairyland in all their glory” included these storybook favorites: “Little Bo-Peep”; “Cinderella”; “Mary Mary, Quite Contrary”; “Mary Had a Little Lamb”; “Red Riding Hood”; “Little Miss Muffet”; “Little Tommy Tucker”; “Little Boy Blue”; “My Pretty Maid”; “Little Girl with a Little Curl”; “The Queen of Hearts”; “Bobby Shaf-toe”; “Little Polly Flinders”; “Curlylocks”; “Polly Put The Kettle On!”, and “Peter Piper”.

Each card interior featured a condensed, rhyming version of the beloved character’s back story. For parents seeking to speed up those requests for yet another bedtime story, these cut-to-the-chase Hallmark capsules proved a time-saver. Better yet, tucked inside each and every poem was an easy-to-digest moral for little ones to learn from: Some were fairly obvious: “Red Riding Hood?” Don’t talk to strangers. “Little Boy Blue?” No sleeping on

the job. Other sermon-ettes took a bit more leeway with their original source material, like “Little Polly Flinders” who “sat among the cinders.”. The reason, according to Hallmark: Polly’s feet were cold and wet, because she didn’t wear her overshoes when she went outside to play in the snow. (“Polly learned her lesson, and told her mother then, ‘I’ll

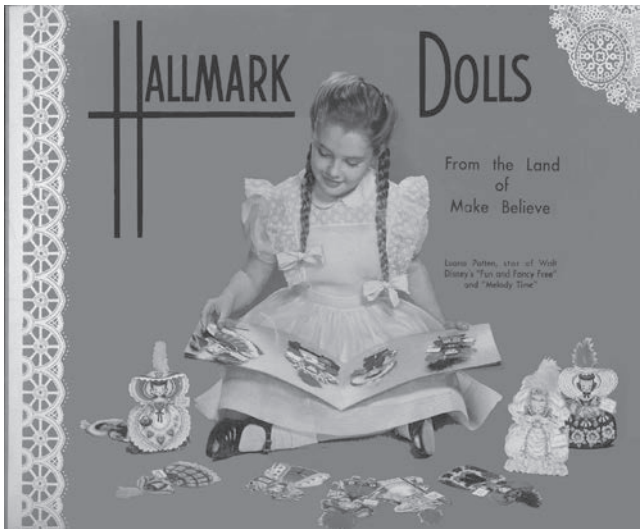
always mind you after this and not be bad again.”)

The success of “Dolls From The Land of Make Believe” led to 1948’s “Dolls of the Nations.” This brand-new set of 16, again with Luana on the album cover, welcomed the following visitors from other lands: “Sing Toy of China”; “Maria of Mexico”; Antoinette of France”; “Rita of

Brazil”; Katrinka of Holland”; “John, A Royal Canadian Mountie”; “Ann of England”; “Kathleen of Ireland”; “Christina of Sweden”; “Monty of Australia”; “Barbel of Switzerland”; “Sandy of Scotland”, and “Kusum of India.” The United States was represented by “Cowboy Joe”. Also

present, in their pre-U.S. incarnations, were “Tautuk of Alaska” and “Lei-lani of Hawaii.”

As with the “Make Believe” series, the “Dolls of the Nations” cards featured interior rhymes, with title lettering suggesting the country of origin. This time around, however, there were no familiar nursery tales to rely on. Instead, each poem took the form of a whirlwind tour through the character’s homeland. A sampling:

“Sandy lives in Scotland, so he’s called a little Scot—

And if you saw his country you would like it such a lot

For you could hike through mountains, and climb over cliffs and rocks,

And see a lot of pretty lakes (the Scotch folks call them ‘lochs’).”

“Dolls of the Nations” provided a painless and palatable dose of social studies laced with geography lessons. The end product was guaranteed to appeal to young minds just beginning to explore the world around them.

1949’s “Little Women Dolls” which proved the

most popular of the Hallmark series, are also the most difficult to find today. That’s because, unlike the other Hallmark sets, the four “Little Women” dolls have significant appeal as cross-collectibles. Interest in them extends beyond paper doll collectors to those whose passion is movie memorabilia. Released to coincide with the 1949 MGM movie based on Louisa May Alcott’s enduring novel, each 6 by 5 inch “Little Women” doll is costumed to resemble a specific character in the film: “Jo” (June Allyson); “Meg” (Janet Leigh); “Amy” (Elizabeth Tay-

lor); and “Beth” (Margaret O’Brien).

On-the-set sketches of the performers by artist Smith added to the authenticity of the dolls’ “look” (and proved a good publicity ploy for both MGM and Hallmark).

Hallmark dolls originally sold for just 25 cents each (50 cents with the album). Today, individual dolls in mint condition can fetch from \$40-45, with each “Little Women” doll averaging \$50-75. Just right for any young (or young-at-heart) doll collector you may know—especially if
